- Mandatory Female Dress Code:

1. The dress should not hang below the gown. If wearing slacks, the slacks should be a dark color.
2. The shoes should be of medium heel and no athletic shoes or flip-flops are permitted.
3. Do not wear flowers or ornaments of any kind.
4. Do not carry a purse. (All purses can be locked up if you so desire.)
5. No bandanas, headwear, or sunglasses are permitted.

- Mandatory Male Dress Code:

1. A white dress shirt is required. (A tie is optional.)
2. Dark trousers are required.
3. Dress shoes are required. No athletic shoes, sandals, or flip-flops are permitted.
4. No bandanas, headwear, or sunglasses are permitted.

- All male graduates are required to report to Mr. Hogue's room (211) by 5:45 pm

- All female graduates are required to report to Mrs. Yantes' room (212) by 5:45 pm

- All seniors will report to line up in the proper hallway at 6:50 pm

- Commencement will begin promptly at 7:00 pm

Please remember the following details:

1. All records must be completed, all financial obligations paid, including cafeteria fees and items returned before you will be permitted to go through commencement.
2. Conduct that is unacceptable in the days prior to or on the day of commencement could lead to non-participation in the ceremony.
