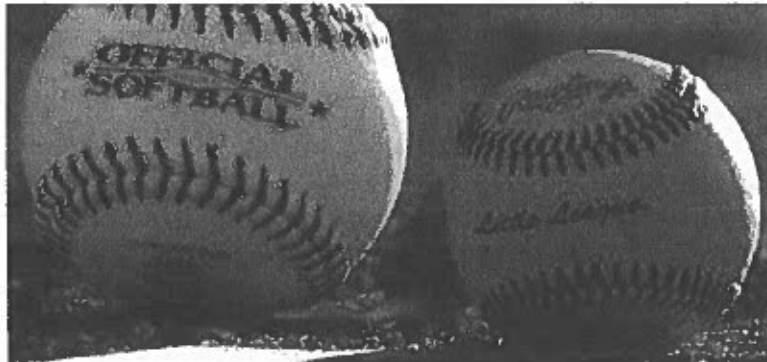


# **Jackson-Milton Hot Stove**

Registration: **\$80/player** for baseball & softball, **\$40/player** for t-ball  
**To guarantee a place on a team please register by February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022.**

*Timely registration expedites the setting of team rosters and coaches,  
and also allows players to participate in open gym and practices.*

Uniform sizes can be selected on the online form.

There will also be in-person uniform fittings and paper registrations during the Harry M. Lay Basketball Tournament on the weekends of January 15-16, 22-23, and 29-30.

By mid-February, coaches will notify those registered with additional information regarding team rosters, practice schedules, etc.

## 1. Volunteer/buyout options

The Jackson-Milton Hot Stove Association requests that each family provides at least one adult volunteer to work at **either our annual Field Day, tentatively scheduled for Sunday, March 20th,**

**OR our annual cow drop fundraiser, held this year on Friday, May 13th .**

If this option is selected during registration, you will be required to submit a \$50 check per family as a deposit guarantee to provide volunteer services to receive your child's uniform. This check will be returned upon completion of your volunteer services. However, if you do not provide any volunteer services, the check will be cashed and utilized as your buy-out fee. Volunteer signup times will be communicated through email/text when the schedules are available (please check the email address used during registration for this information). If the family is unable to provide a volunteer, you may instead select the \$50.00 per family buyout option. Selecting the buyout will add \$50.00 to your registration fees. We encourage you to consider volunteering your time. Thank you!

## 2. Annual fundraiser/buyout options

The Jackson-Milton Hot Stove requests that each family sell at least 4 tickets for our annual cow drop fundraiser, held this year on **Friday, May 13th.**

Tickets are \$20 each. Once tickets are distributed later in the season, you may purchase the tickets so you can attend the event, or you may sell the tickets to friends/family so they can attend the event. Ticket stubs and more information will be provided to families at a later date. If you are interested in selling more than 4 tickets, please contact your coach or a Hot Stove board member once the season begins. A family may choose to not sell fundraiser tickets and may select the \$50.00 per family buyout option below. Choosing the buyout option will add \$50 to your registration fees. We encourage you to consider attending this event! Thank you!
